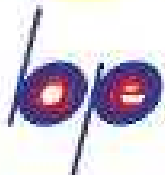

Why Biomass?

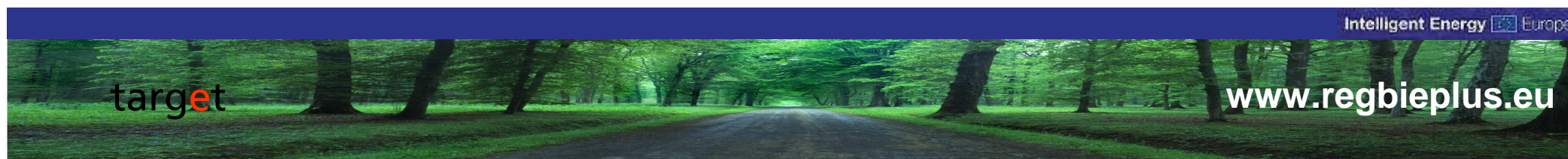


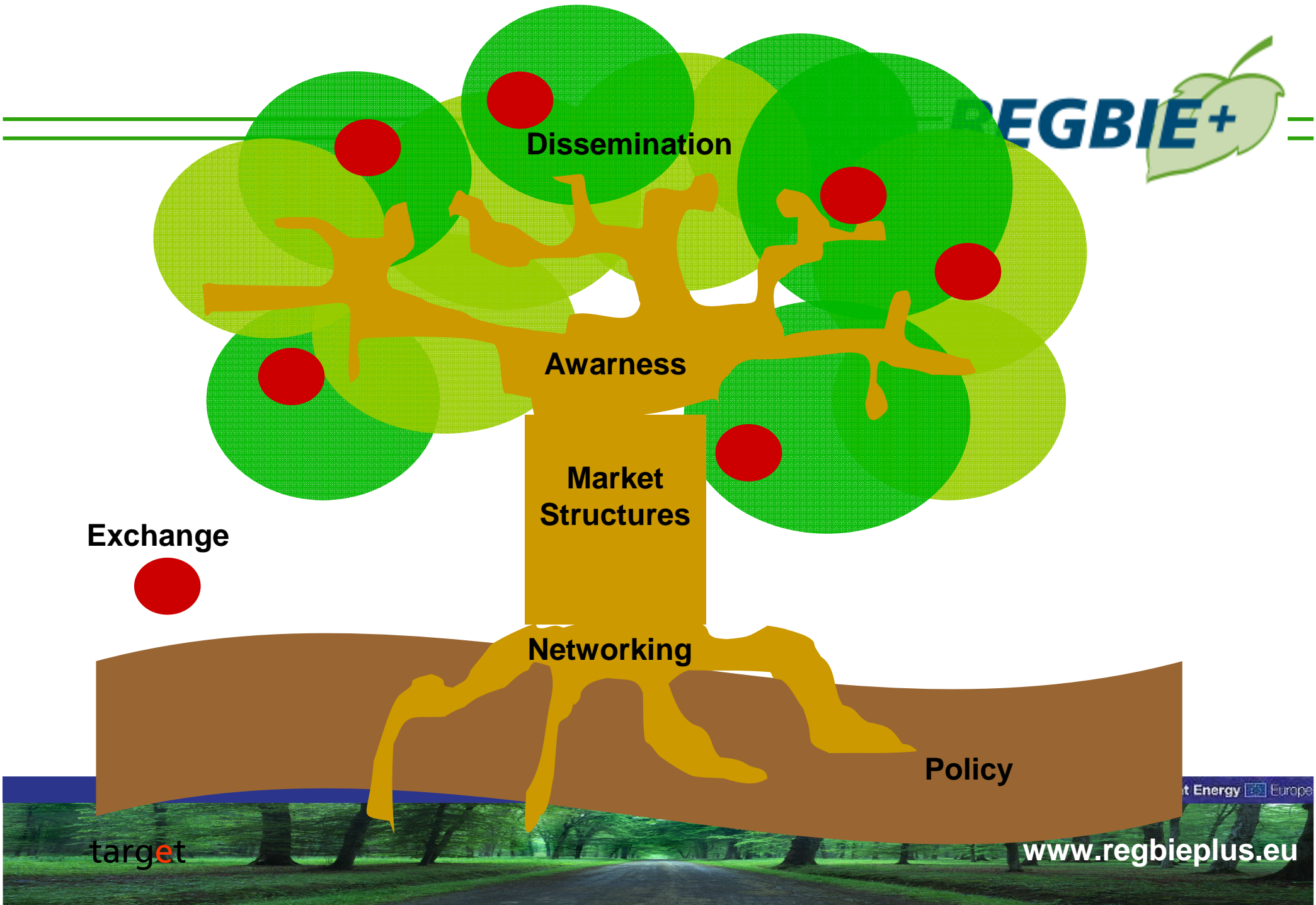
In 2005, biomass and wastes constituted about 5 % (or 82 Mtoe) of the EU's energy consumption in the EU-27

Bioenergy contributes about 64 % of all RES primary energy requirements of the EU (98 % of RES heat and 9 % of RES electricity)

The EC Renewable Energy Roadmap estimates that 195 Mtoe of biomass is needed to achieve the 20 % RES goal by 2020

Biomass is expected to contribute 2/3 to the 20 % RES objective of 2020

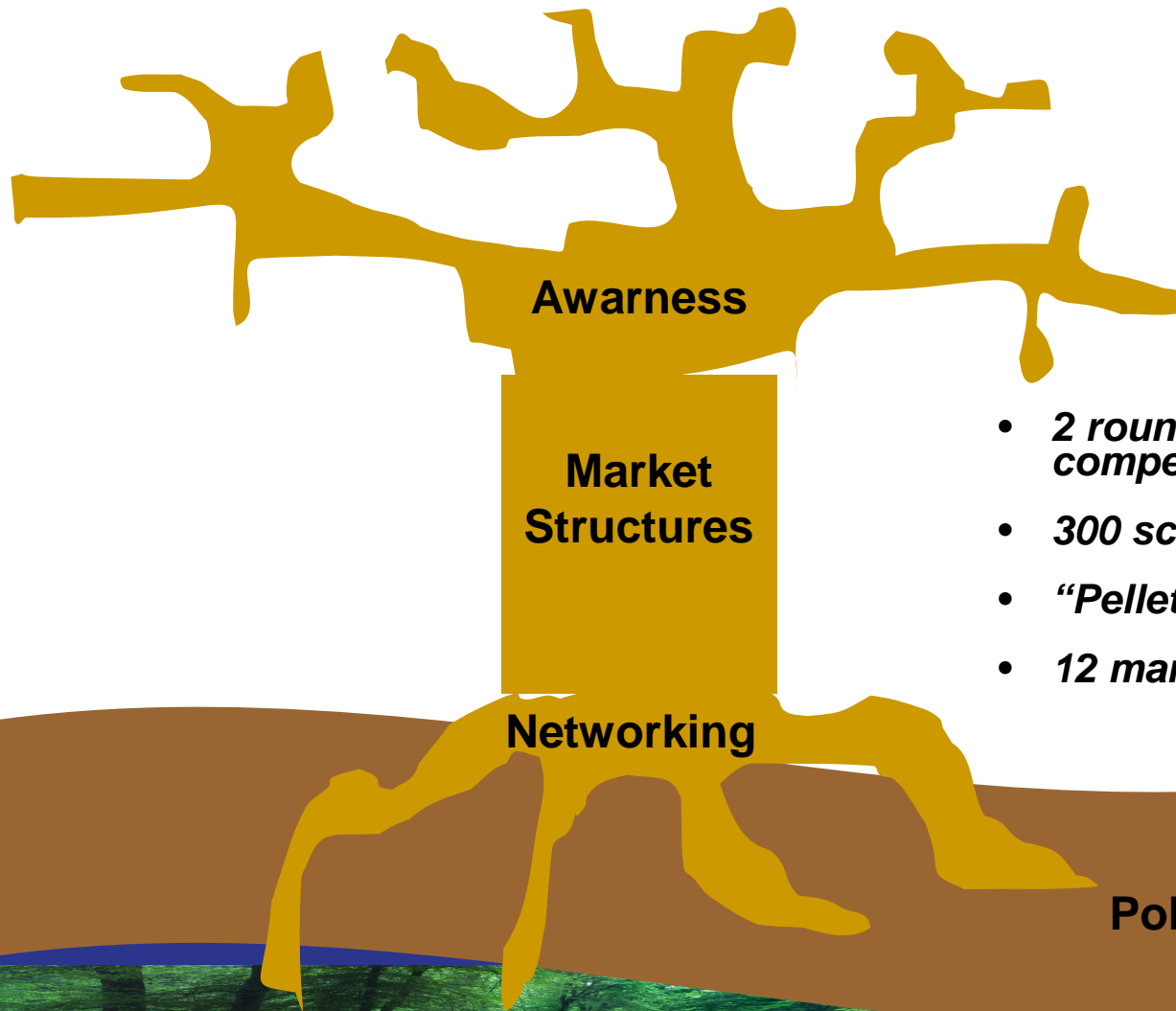

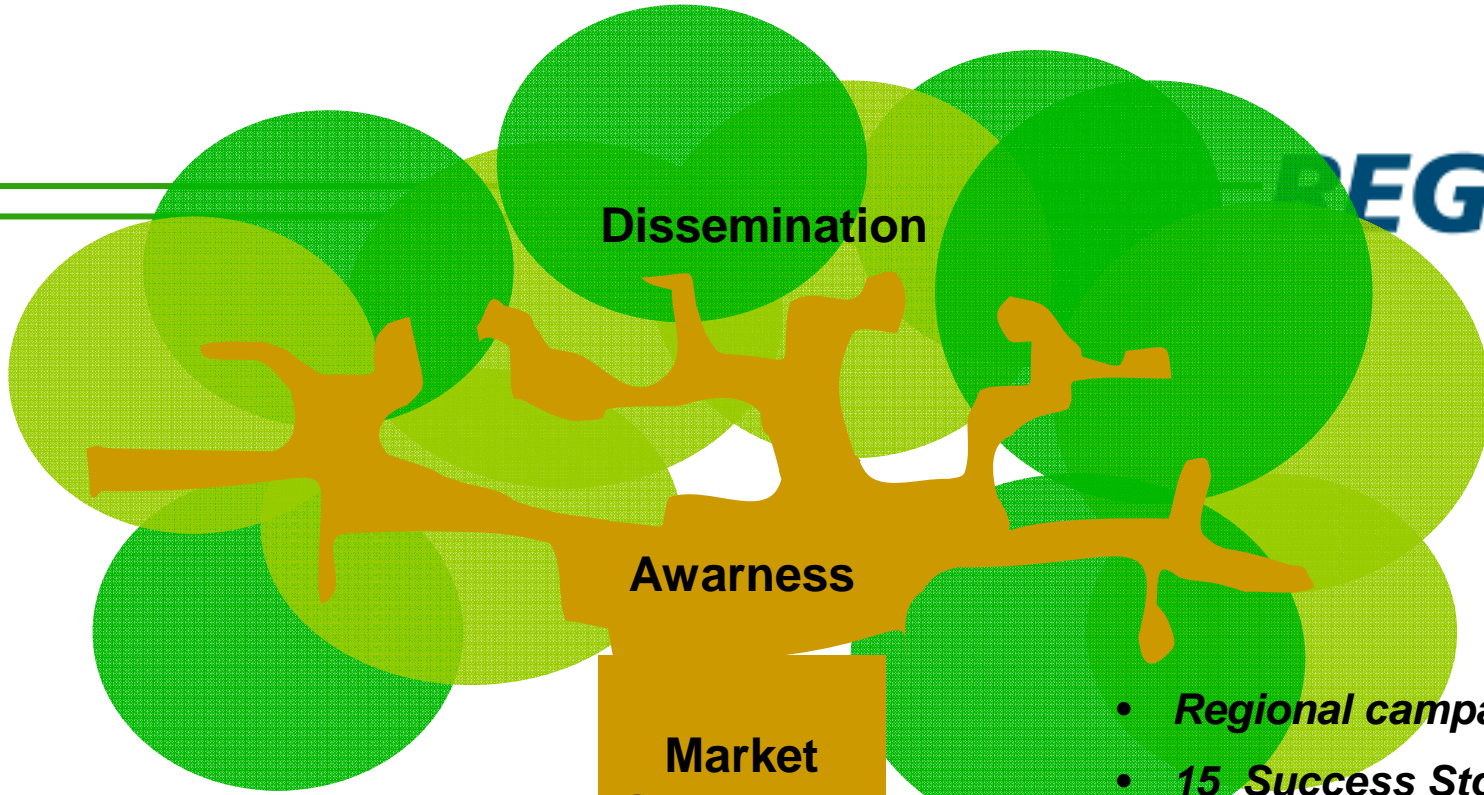

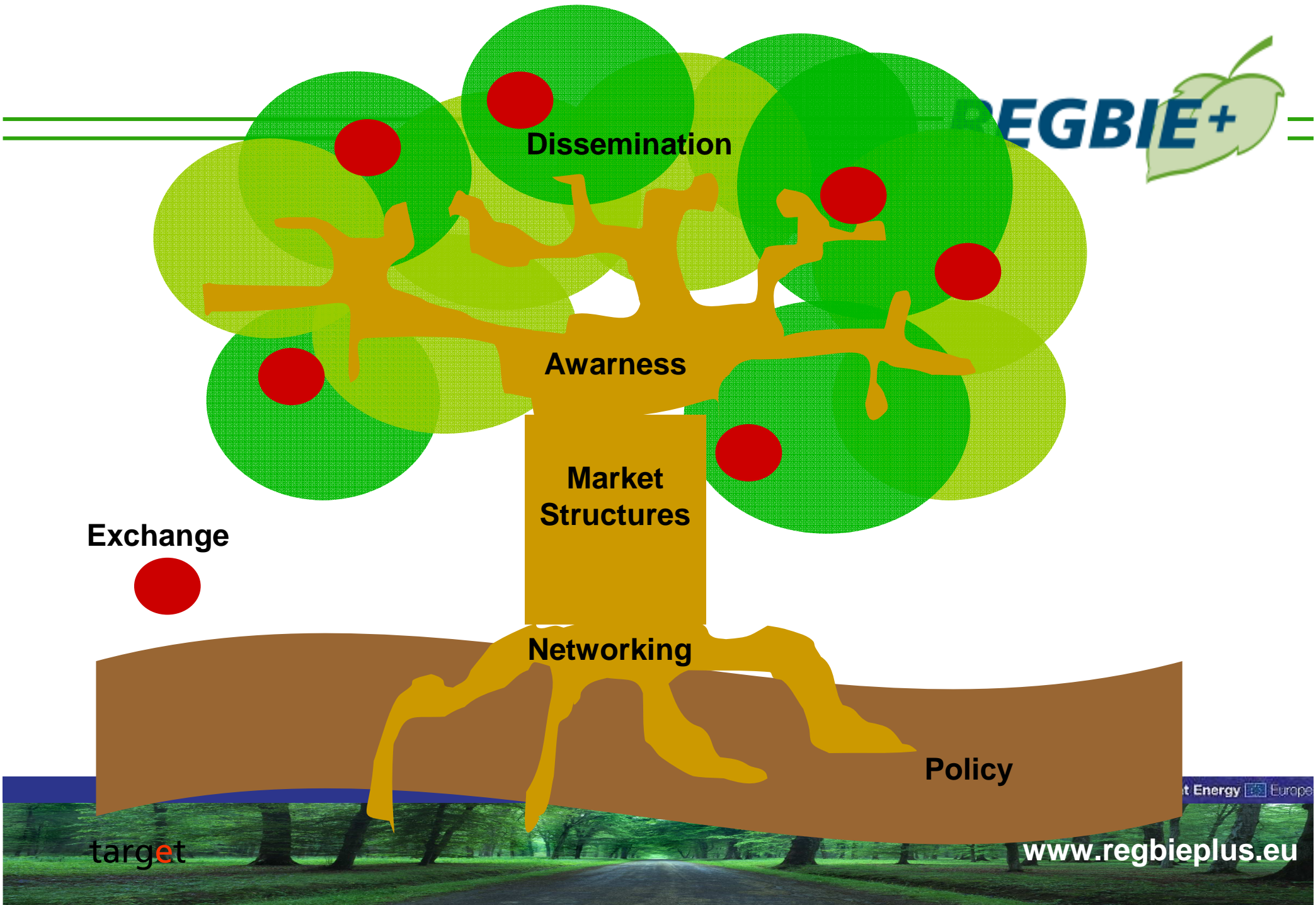
